

Job Description
Part Time Worship Leader

Spiritual Qualifications:

The Worship Leader should demonstrate a passion for Christ and his Kingdom through personal spiritual discipline, worship theology and public ministry.

General Duties:

1. Meet weekly with the Assistant Pastor to create a well-planned and Spirit-filled worship service, which includes selecting appropriate music to compliment the sermon.
2. Oversee and coordinate all musical aspects of the contemporary worship services.
3. Lead our current team of vocalists and instrumentalists; recruit and develop other musicians as needed.
4. Lead the congregation in contemporary worship and prayer at weekly Sunday morning worship services.
5. Organize necessary rehearsals and Sunday morning warmup.
6. Work with, train, recruit and schedule audio visual volunteers.
7. Administrative duties, including the preparation of slides for worship software and other visual aids for overhead projection.
8. Periodically review all audio visual equipment to make sure that everything is in good working order. If anything needs repaired or new equipment needs to be purchased, prepare estimates for approval by the Worship Committee and the Session.
9. Any additional duties as agreed upon by the Worship Leader, Pastor and Worship Committee.
10. Lead in periodic special worship services throughout the year, potentially including Holy Week, Christmas or others.

Other Duties/Information:

1. The Worship Leader reports directly to the Assistant Pastor under the supervision of the Senior Pastor.
2. Weekly staff meeting attendance is not required, but may be requested periodically.
3. The Worship Leader position falls under the responsibility of the Worship Committee.
4. In addition to the specific Job Description, all employees shall perform ministerial functions, which are an integral part of employment at Faith Presbyterian Church. These ministerial functions include, but are not limited to:
 - leading and/or participating in staff devotions and/or prayer
 - sharing the Gospel with visitors or others when called upon to do so during the work day
 - providing spiritual resources
 - praying with visitors or callers when appropriate
 - communicating bible teachings in written or verbal communication
5. The Worship Leader will also be required to live on- and off-duty in accordance with the Statement of Faith, Code of Christian Conduct, and general beliefs of Faith Presbyterian Church Germantown.

Hours:

This position is Part Time. The Worship Leader is expected to work Sunday mornings and other agreed-upon times, whether on site or off to organize the services. We expect this position to be a 10-12 hour/week commitment.

Compensation: The weekly compensation is \$300, not based on hourly work.

Benefits:

1. Four Sundays off per calendar year (unpaid)
